

## **OGP Standards Workshop, Bangkok, 11 – 12 March 2010**

### **Workshop Resolution**

Following the workshop presentations and the roundtable discussion on the second day, the following resolutions have been agreed by the participants:

- 1) PTTEP desires to participate in the OGP Standards committee and will appoint representative(s) in the near future.
- 2) Form a Standards coordination committee comprising PTTEP (Chair), PTT, Chevron Thailand E+P, TISI, PTIT, DMF and other interested operators, contractors etc. with the objectives of:
  - a) Formalizing a national standards committee for the oil & gas industry in Thailand.
  - b) Promoting the use of common international standards in Thailand.
  - c) To act as the national mirror committee for appropriate ISO and IEC committees (initially ISO/TC 67).
  - d) Consider to change Thailand's membership in ISO/TC 67 from O- to P-member.
  - e) Consider to adopt as TISI standards relevant standards from ISO/TC67 and other relevant ISO and IEC committees.
  - f) Consider for Thailand to participate at the plenary meetings of ISO/TC67, next in Doha, Qatar 26-27 October 2010.
  - g) Sharing experiences on implementation of international standards.
  - h) Increasing understanding of international standards implementation between members.
- 3) Identify the champion and members to lead and participate in the national standard committee.
- 4) Require more investigation and study ISO standards contents, potentially by the national standards committee and/or in a future workshop in Thailand.
