RSPP suggestions in technical regulation system in Russia

Committee for technical regulation,
standardization and conformity assessment
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After adopting of “technical regulation Law”, the following systems are to be reformed:

- **Accreditation**
- **Certification**
- **Standardization**
- **Control and supervision**
- **Metrology**

More than 40 federal bodies of executive branch of Power take part in the reform.

Should be amended:

- **90 laws**
- **800 current by-laws of Russian Federation**
- **120000branch legal documents (branch regulations, directive documents, technical specifications)**

Committee for technical regulation, standardization and conformity assessment

- Working group for technical regulation was created under Russian Union of Industrialists and Entrepreneurs (RSPP) in October 2004;
- On the 6 of February, 2006 working group was modified in RSPP Committee for technical regulation, standardization and conformity assessment;
- Committee includes more than 650 representatives of industry, scientific community, industrial groups and unions.

Committee for technical regulation, standardization and conformity assessment tasks:

- To involve industry in the reform of technical regulation and standardization;
- To coordinate efforts of industrialists and entrepreneurs, scientific community, industrial groups and unions during the reforming of the technical regulation and standardization;
- To realize coordination between industrialists and Russian Government.

Committee for technical regulation, standardization and conformity assessment activity:

- Analytical monitoring of the reforming process of the national technical regulation system;
- To inform regions in Russian Federation about the reforming process;
- To study international and national experience of different countries in the field of technical regulation, standardization, accreditation and conformity assessment;
- To restructure current system of Russian technical committees for standardization in the frame of intersectoral councils.

Information of regions in Russian Federation about reforming process



- More that 15 conferences were held in Ural, Midland, South, North-West, Siberian, Volzhskiy regions and in Tatarstan

- Business visit of RSPD delegation in Institute for standardization of Germany DIN to learn the experience of German industry participation in the work on development of standards and European directives (Berlin, Frankfurt on Main, May, 2006)
- To participate in the Working Party on Regulatory Cooperation and Standardization Policies Economic and Social Council UNITED NATIONS, working group for harmonization of standardization between TC/CEN 12 and Russia

Work on restructuring of current Russian system in technical Committees for standardization in the frame of international Councils:

Under the Committee the following agencies were created:

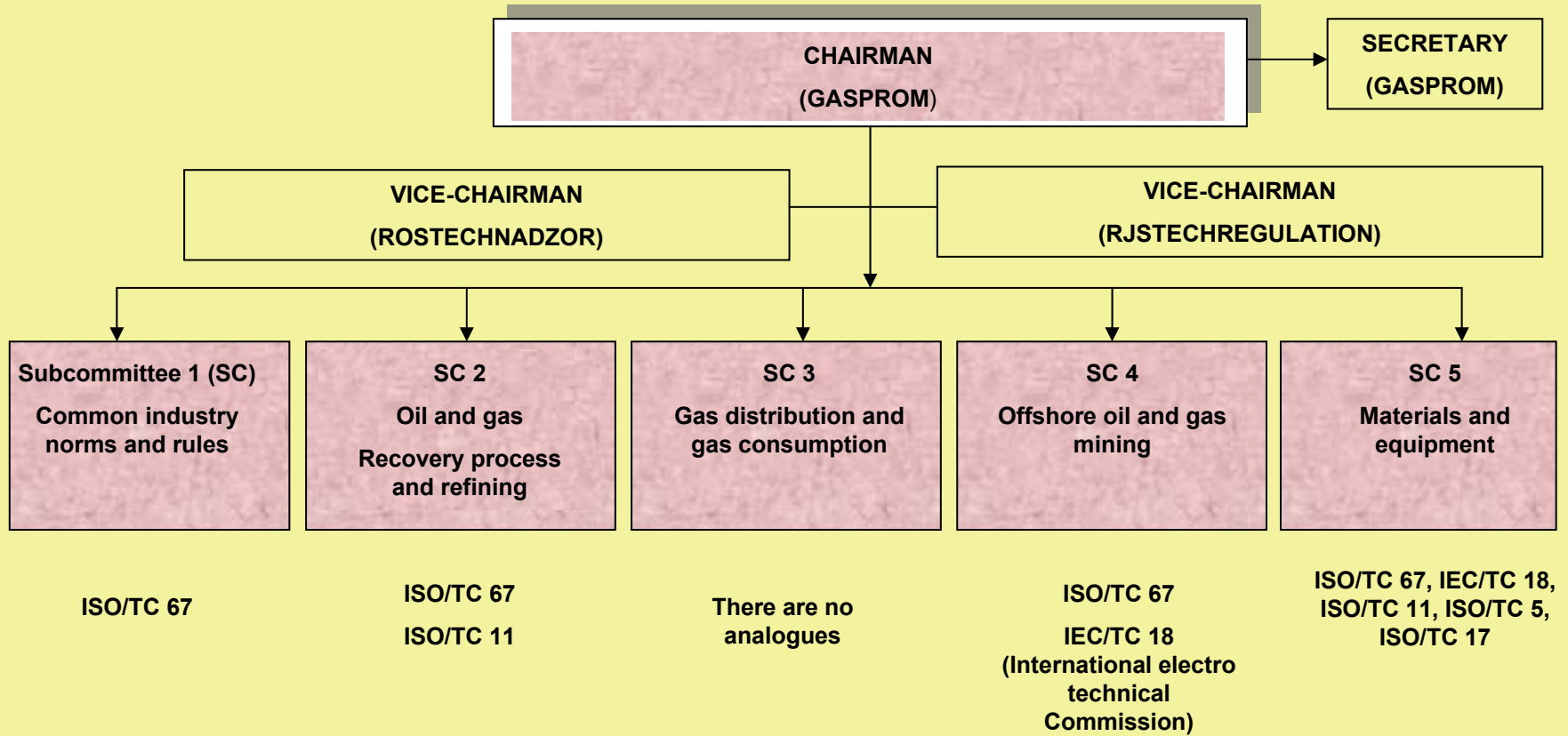
- Intersectoral Council for standardization in oil and gas complex in Russia ;
- Intersectoral Council for technical regulation in construction;
- Intersectoral Council for technical regulation in metallurgy;
- Accreditation Council.

The main aim of Councils – to create single position on the questions of standardization and technical regulation in branch.

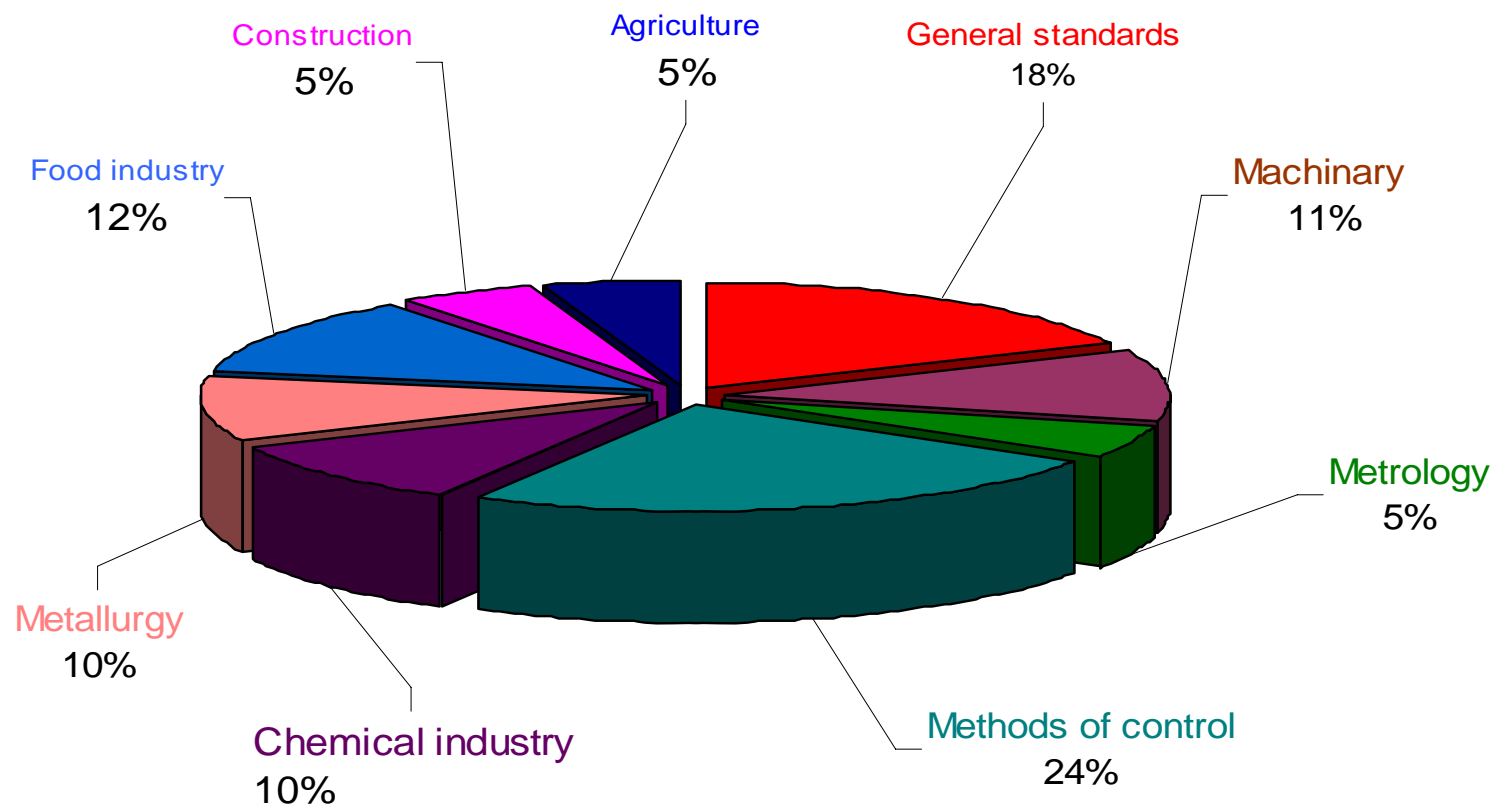
Tendencies of national standardization system (NSS)

- Improving of NSS legal framework
- Strengthening of the national standardization role in the decisions of state tasks and role in the development of the State
- Development of functional NSS structure
- Development of economic basis in standardization
- Development of NSS documents fund
- Development of international support in standardization
- Improving of cooperation with international and regional organizations for standardization
- Development of works on staff preparation, reduction and upgrading qualification in the field of standardization

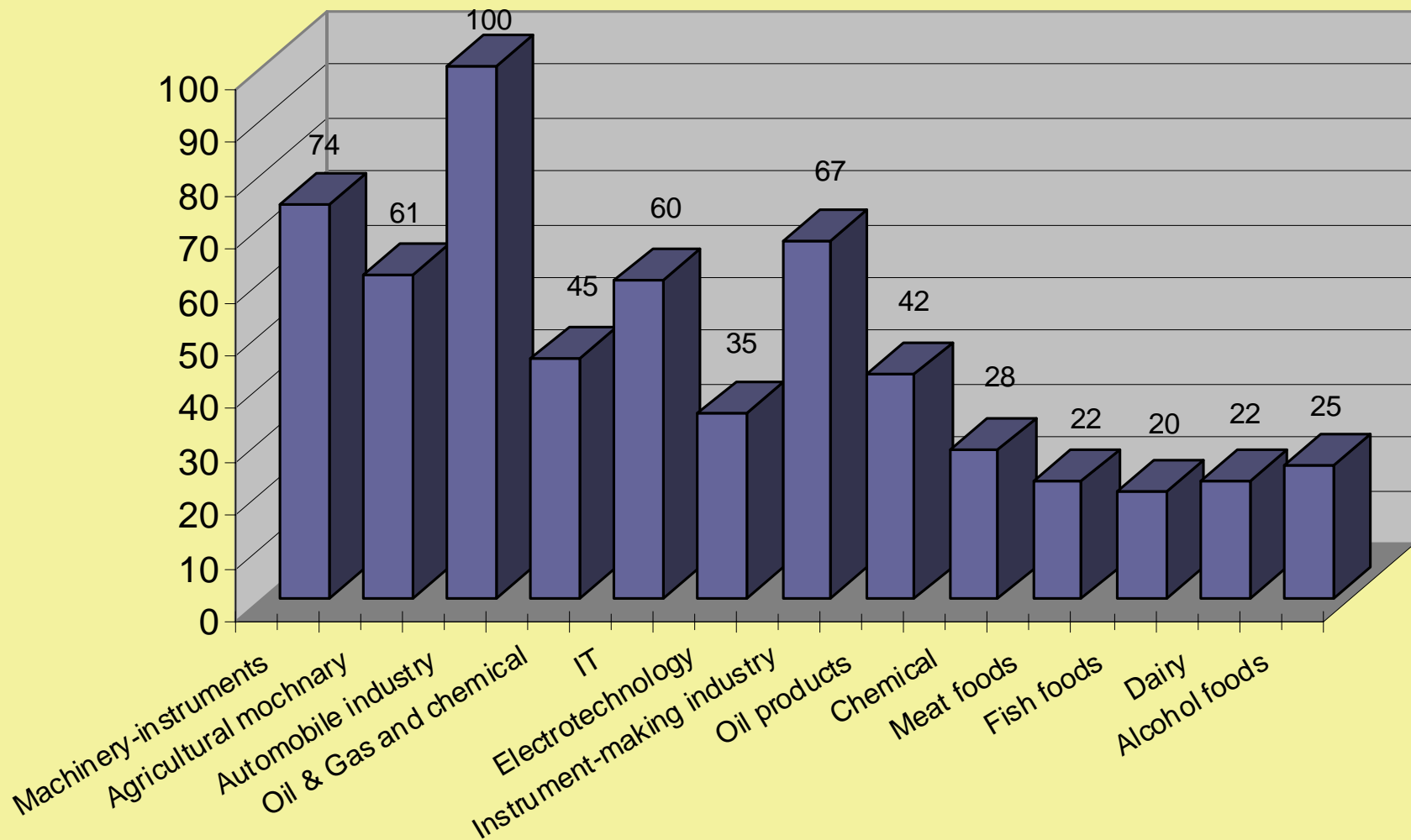
Technical Committee (TC) org structure
