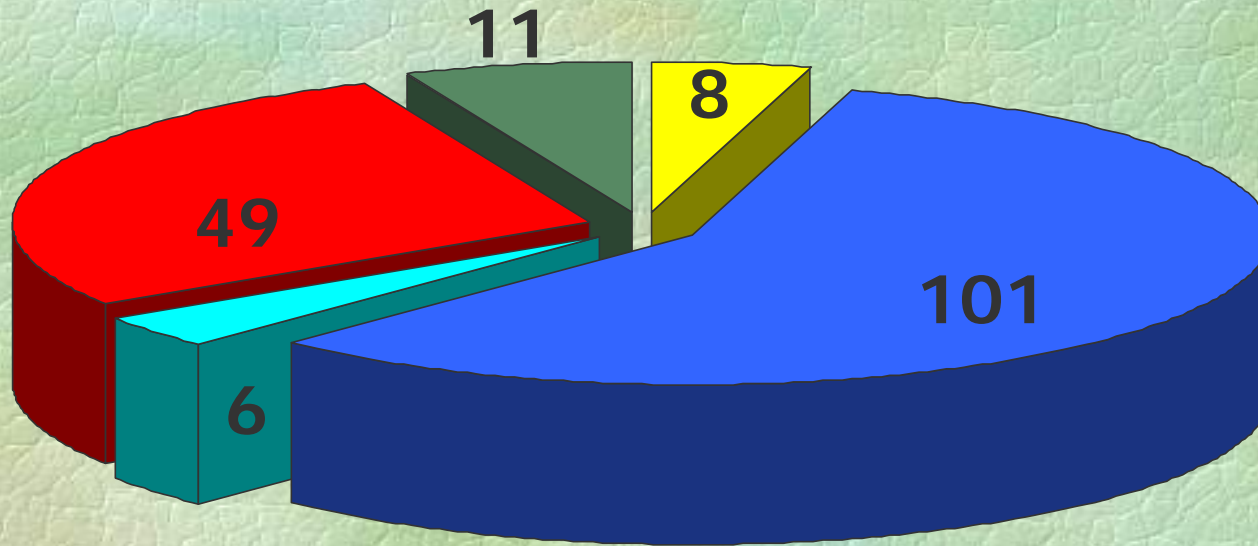

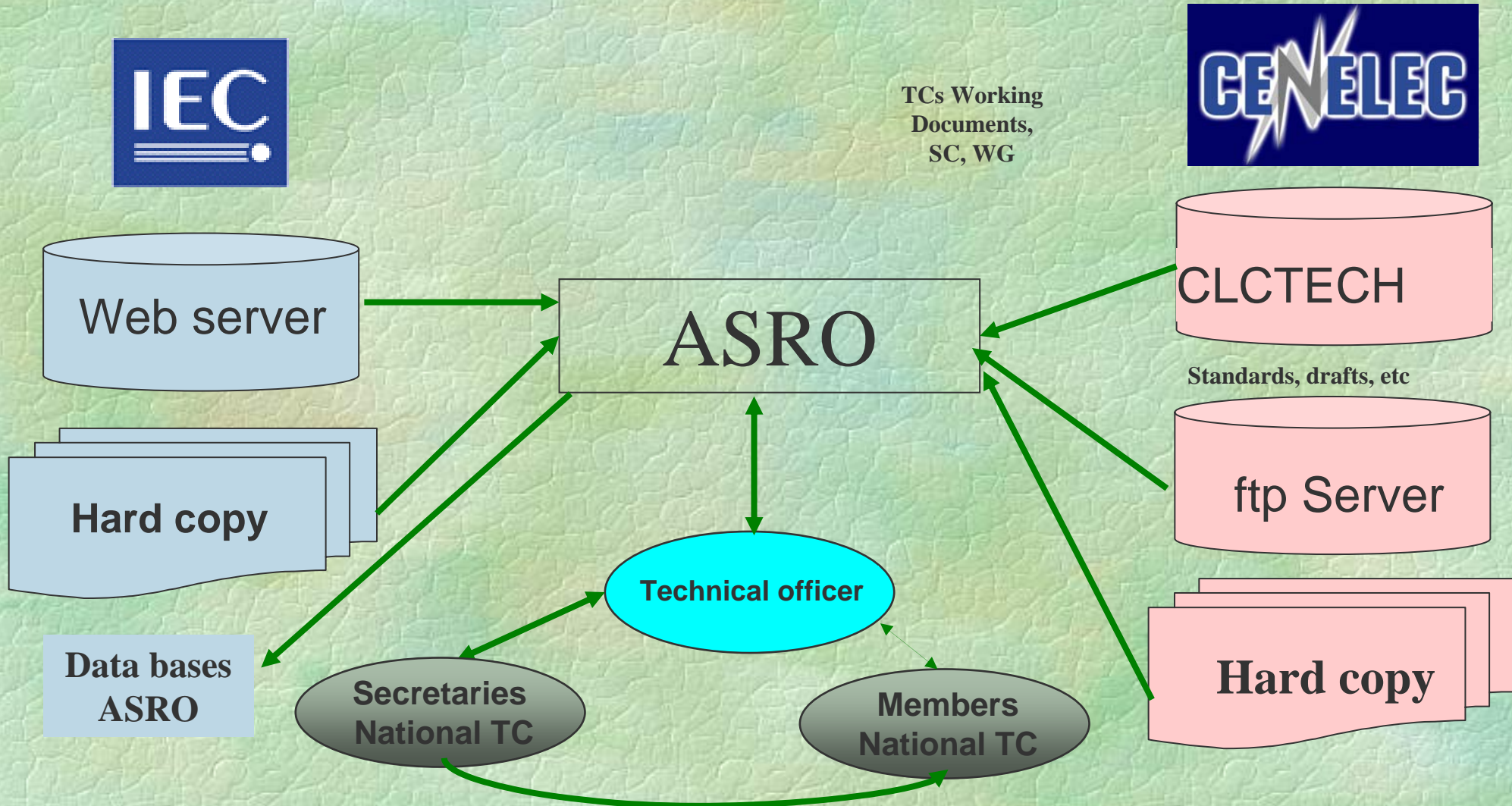

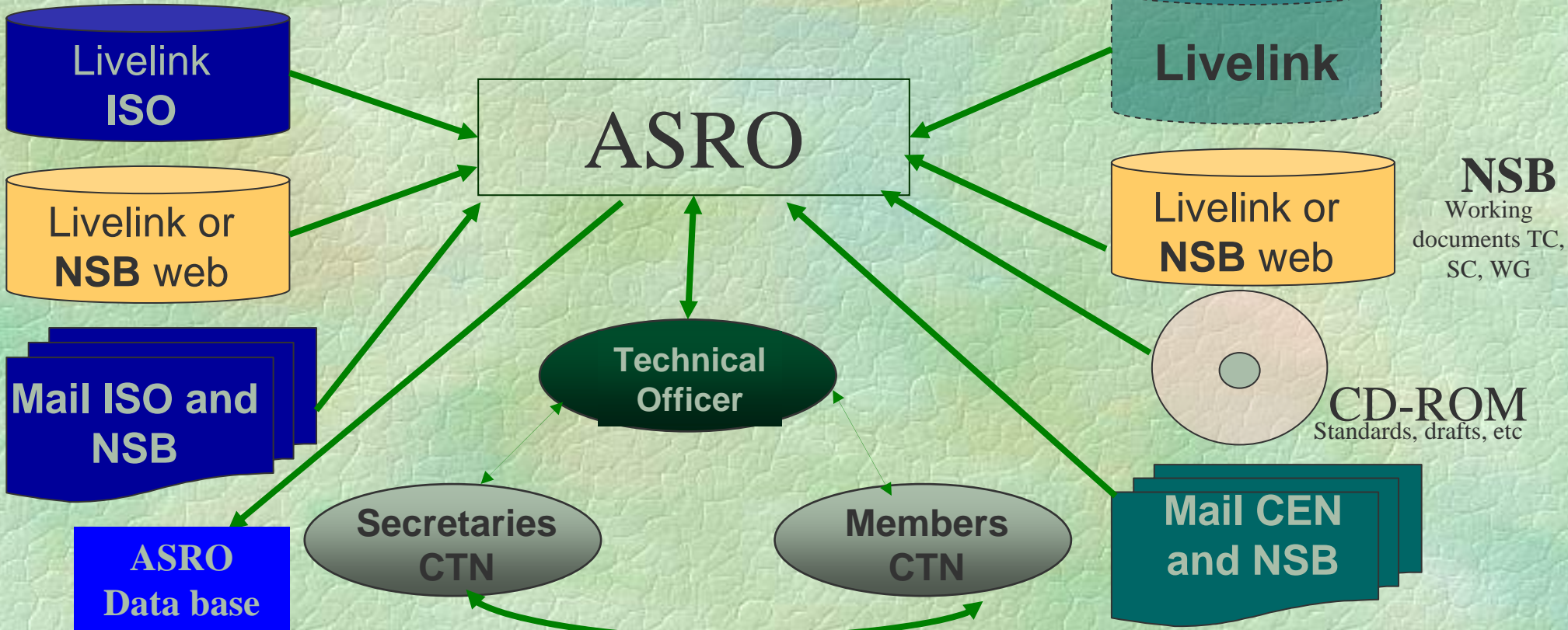
Interface between ASRO and European and International standardization bodies

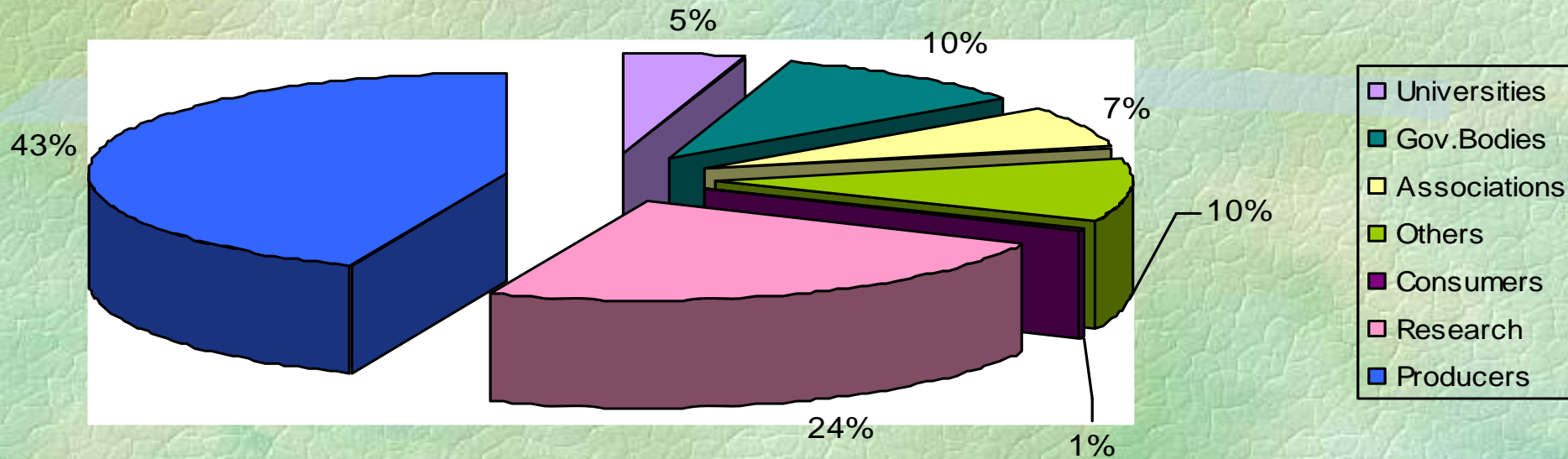

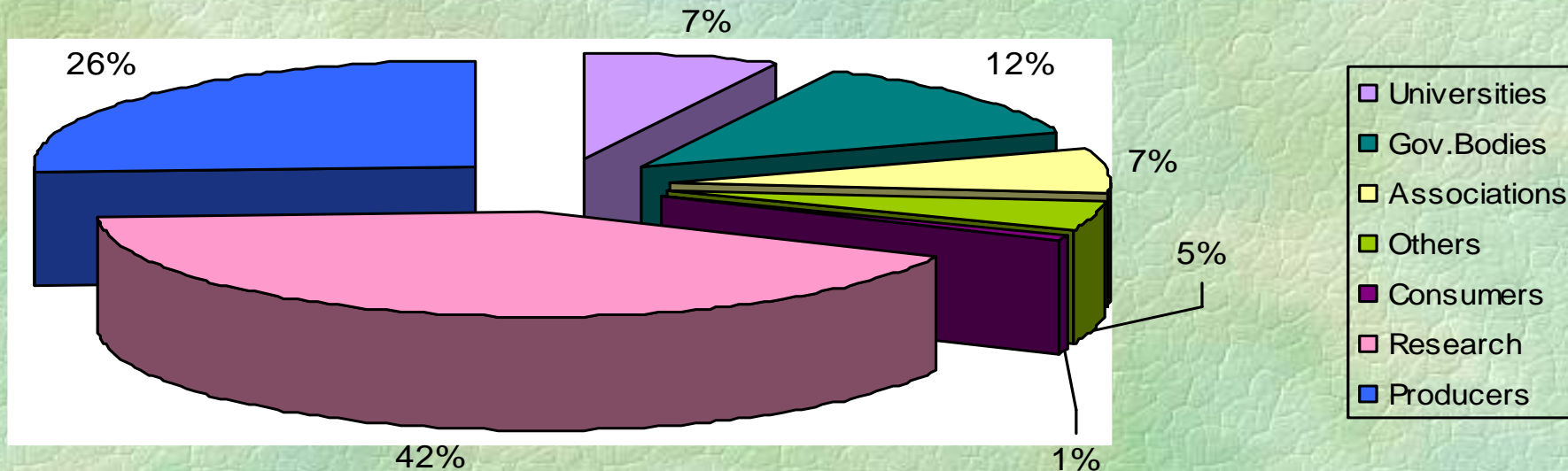

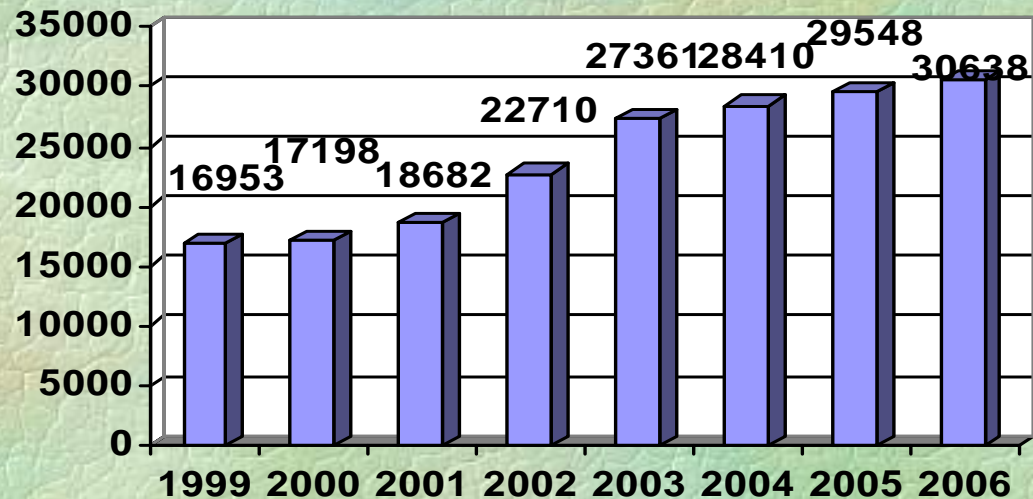

Natural entities - members of ASRO TCs



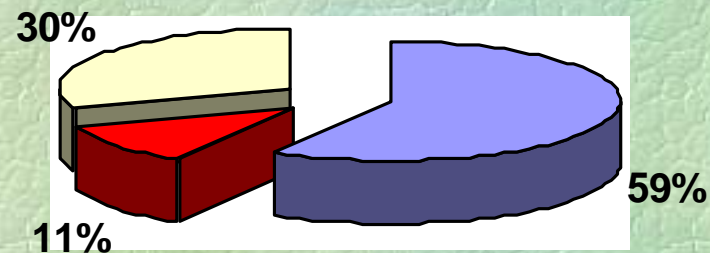
Annual evolution of the Romanian valid no. of standards



Of the total of Romanian valid standards on **31.12.2006**

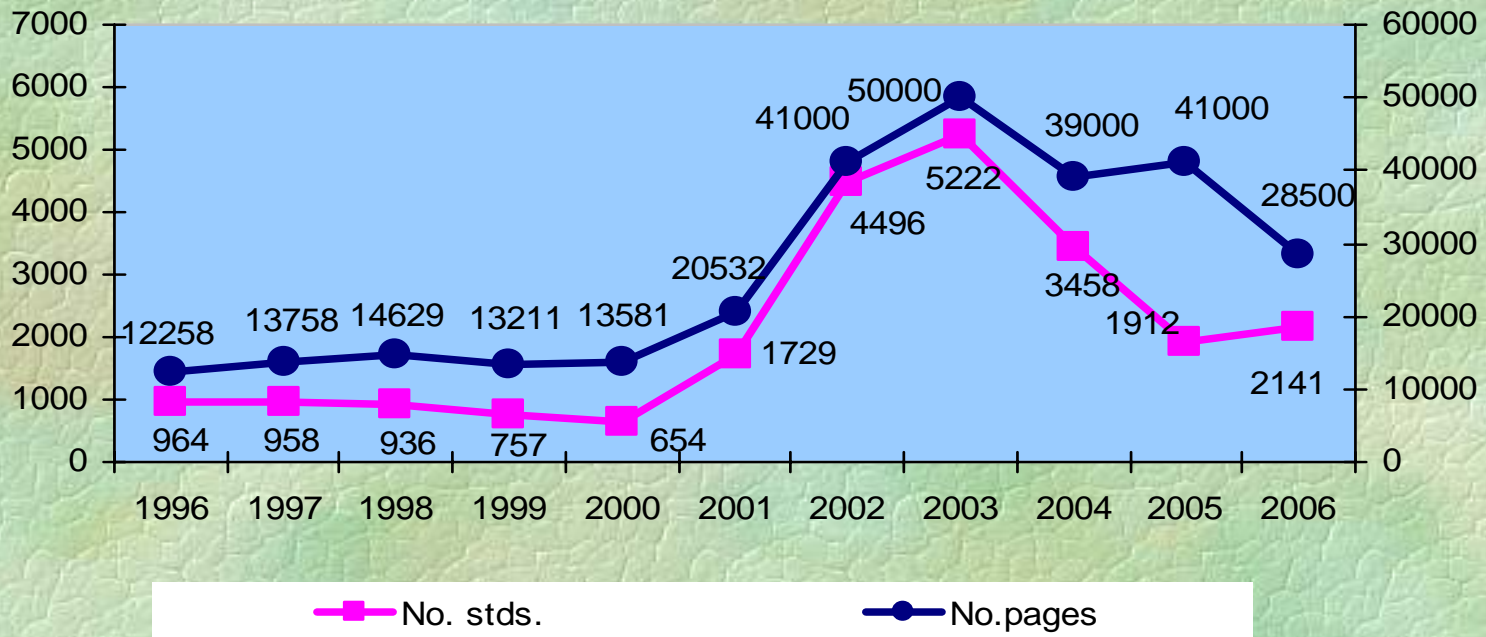
- Total standards **30368**

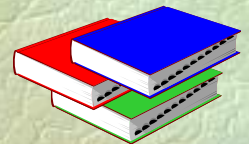

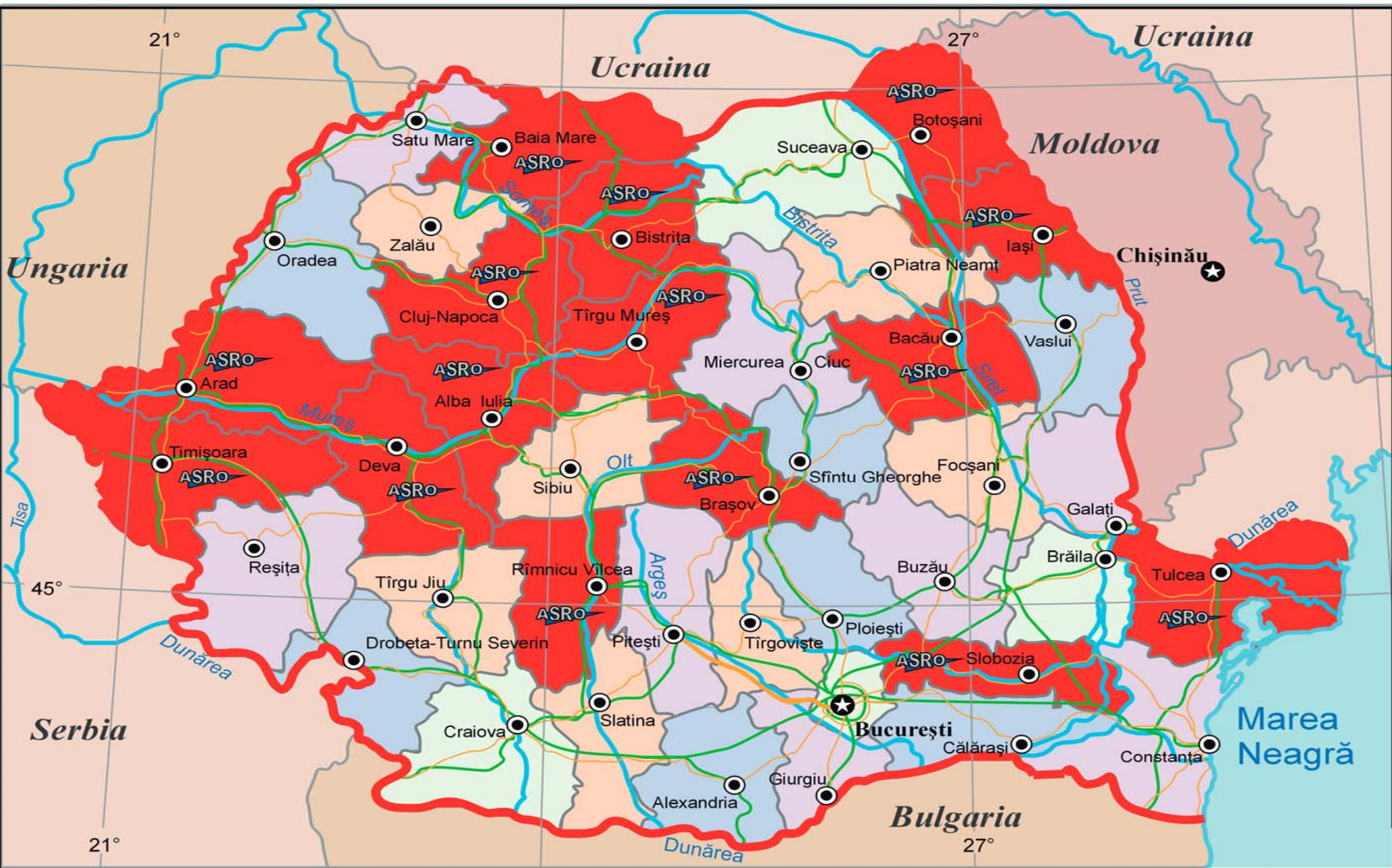

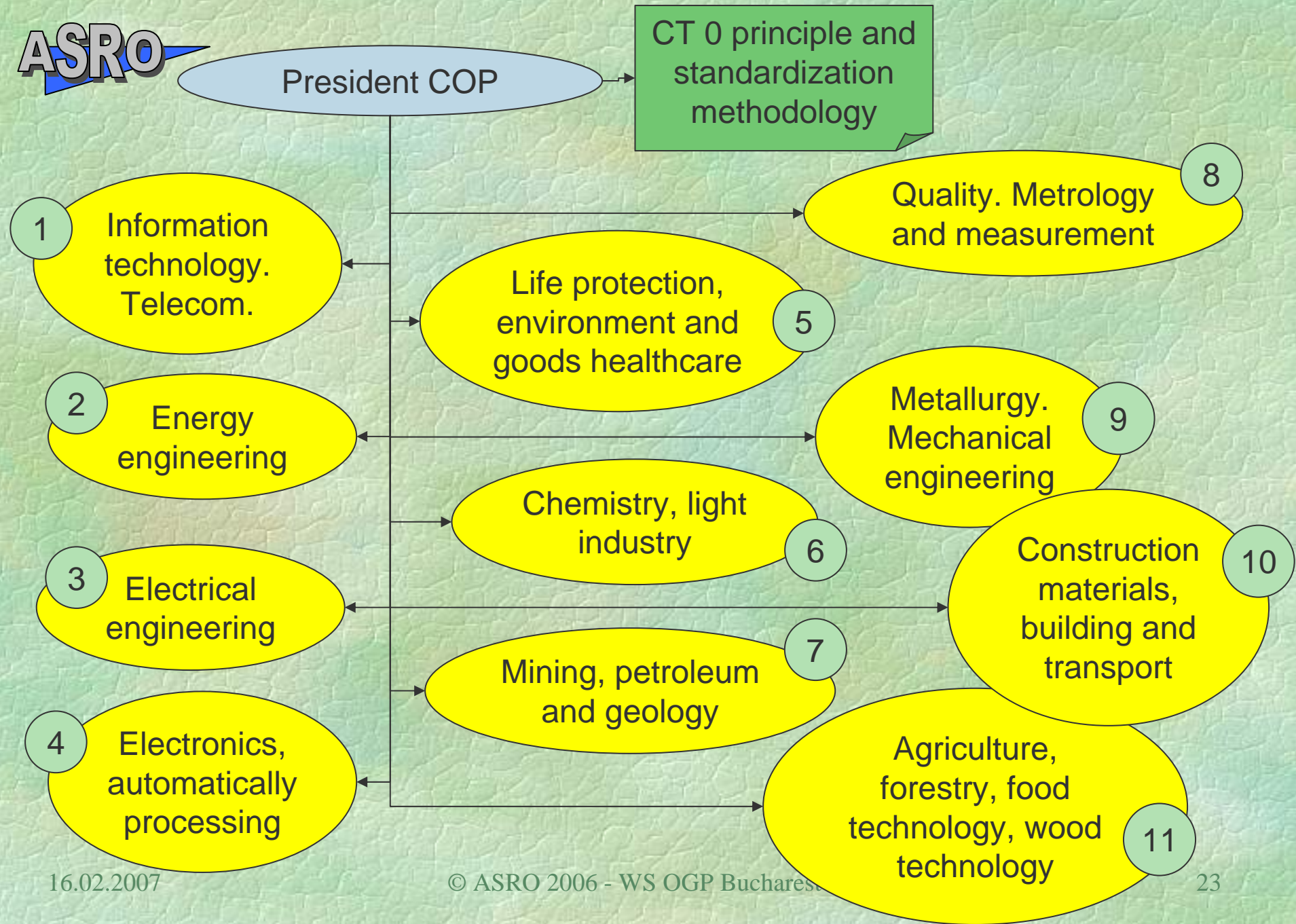
New way for national collaboration
